Anderson Named Taxpayer Champion

WACO – State Rep. Charles “Doc” Anderson today was recognized in Waco by the state’s leading taxpayer advocacy organization for his record working on behalf of sound fiscal principles and economic priorities.

Anderson received the Taxpayers Champion Award from Texans for Fiscal Responsibility. The award is presented based on Anderson’s rating on the organization’s Fiscal Responsibility Index. Anderson was one of only four members of the Texas Legislature to score a 100% rating in the recently concluded Session, according to the organization’s president, Michael Quinn Sullivan.

“All Texans, but especially the men and women in the Waco area, have benefited from Rep. Anderson’s commonsense approach to stewarding the taxpayers’ resources. Rep. Anderson has worked diligently to ensure that Texas has a healthy economy by restraining government growth, limiting mandates on entrepreneurs, and keeping taxes low,” said Sullivan.

“Throughout his service in the Legislature, Doc Anderson has worked to make Texas as strong and vibrant as possible by pursuing public policies that empower Texans and build a healthy future for everyone in the Lone Star State. We need more legislators like Doc Anderson serving Texas in Austin.”
